Unequaled gueridon in palisander on red pine with gold varnishing depicting scrolling foliage, vases, leaves, palmettes and swans. Fluted giltwood pedestal over acanthus leaves ending in a stylized palm-shaped head under the table-top. Weimar Central Germany, circa 1835/40.
